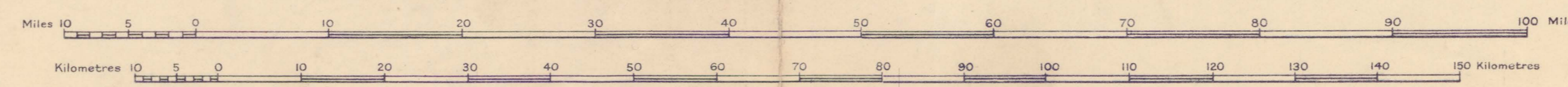
ISOGONAL LINES
